This week Springfield Metro will travel to the Diaper Bank of the Ozarks 615 N Glenstone. There will be a social after at El Maguey located at 631 N Glenstone.

Diaper Bank of the Ozarks keeps babies healthy and happy by providing access to diapers, basic needs, and educational resources to families in need in our community during pregnancy and beyond while increasing diaper need awareness.

The Diaper Bank of the Ozarks has touched the lives of over 55,000 babies over the past 6 years by distributing over 2,000,000

disposable diapers and over 350 cloth diaper starter kits. Between 70 and 80,000 diapers are donated to 40 local partner agencies in Greene County and 29 rural partners reaching into 30 of our outlying counties who then distribute to families in need. The requests for help with diapers come in daily.

The Diaper Bank of the Ozarks partners with 40 agencies serving children in Greene County. These partner agencies include Crosslines, Harmony House, Lifehouse Crisis Maternity Home, Doula Foundation, Pregnancy Care Center and Republic

Pregnancy Resource Center. They plan to distribute at least 550,000 diapers through these agencies each year.

The Diaper Bank of the Ozarks partners with 29 agencies in the rural counties of the Ozarks, reaching into 30 counties. We plan to distribute at least 300,000 disposable diapers through these agencies each year.
